I only took one star off because I felt the book was short a plus in some respects, though and that more time could've been spent giving more information. While I've also read McWhorter and so have read some tough love for the black community, this is the first book I've read on these types of issues that isn't mostly anecdotal. Among contemporary economists and social theorists, one of the most prolific, intellectually independent, and iconoclastic is Thomas Sowell.

Sowell looks at several societies that have enacted preferential policies. Jul 23, Marcelo Reis rated it it was amazing. Sowell says, these politics are great for people who want to make a living as activists, but there is no incentive to ever STOP being an activist when goals are met.

Of course he cites an example from abroad where affirmative actionism much worse has been well researched and is easy to read. He also raises many questions about the consequences of affirmative action that it's advocates never ask, let alone contemplate.
