Henry Gaskin murdered his wife Elizabeth Gaskin 23 who he strangled and battered in woods on Hednesford Hill on 19 February She was the widow of a conjurer named Thomas Ingleby who, before his death, she had performed with, singing, dancing and assisting with his act.

Whilst on leave from the war in September they rowed. Gaskin picked up the torso and carried it the five or six hundred yards to the gasworks, amazingly unseen. Amazingly at this point she was still alive and conscious. He had met her in the woods near gasworks in Hednesford where he hit her, pushed a stick down her throat and stabbed her with a knife.

It is also home to the Staffordshire Open Art Exhibition. On November 2nd Gaskin would once again return to the Western front but only 9 days later the war would come to an end.
